Operating system installation

Next Unit of Computing (NUC) systems have three USB 2.0 connectors. The installation of a Microsoft Windows 7* or Microsoft Windows 8* operating system (OS) requires the use of a USB optical drive or a USB flash drive. A wired or wireless USB keyboard and mouse or a Bluetooth keyboard and mouse can be used. The instruction examples below use a wired USB keyboard and mouse.

USB optical drive installation

Requirements:

- A separate system to download NUC drivers
- USB optical drive
- USB flash drive
- USB wired mouse
- USB wired keyboard
- CD or DVD of the Windows version to be installed

Operating system installation:

- 1. Plug the USB keyboard and USB mouse into the rear USB ports.
- 2. Plug the USB optical drive into the front USB port.
- 3. Put the Windows disk into the USB optical drive.
- 4. Power on the system.
- 5. Boot to the Windows installation disk.
- 6. Follow the instructions of the Windows installer.
- 7. After the Windows installation is complete, unplug the USB optical drive.
- 8. From a separate system, download the latest NUC drivers from Download Center.
- 9. Copy the downloaded drivers to the USB flash drive.
- 10. Plug the USB flash drive into the front USB port.
- 11. Copy the drivers from the flash drive to the internal drive on the NUC system.
- 12. Install the drivers.
- 13. Connect to the internet.
- 14. Install any Windows updates that are required.

Installation is complete.

USB flash drive installation

Requirements:

- A separate system to download the OS image, download NUC drivers, create the OS installation media and the driver flash drive
- USB flash drive for the OS image
- USB flash drive for the drivers for the NUC system
- USB wired keyboard
- USB wired mouse
- ISO image of the Windows version to be installed
- Windows 7 USB/DVD download tool (also works with Windows 8)

Operating system installation:

- 1. From a separate system. copy the version of the Windows 7 or 8 ISO image you want to install to a USB flash drive for the OS image using the Windows 7 USB/DVD download tool.
- 2. Plug the USB keyboard and USB mouse into the rear USB ports.
- 3. Plug the USB flash drive with the Windows image into the front USB port.
- 4. Power on the system.
- 5. Boot to the USB flash drive.
- 6. Follow the instructions of the Windows installer.
- 7. After the Windows installation is complete, unplug the USB flash drive.
- 8. From a separate system, download the latest NUC drivers from <u>Download Center</u>.
- 9. Copy the downloaded drivers to the USB flash drive for drivers.
- 10. Plug the USB flash drive into the front USB port.
- 11. Copy the drivers from the flash drive to the internal drive on the NUC system.
- 12. Install the drivers.
- 13. Connect to the internet.
- 14. Install any Windows updates that are required.

Installation is complete.
